





Under the direction of Mike Bliss, the Village of Walden Recreation is fortunate to have an active Recreation & Parks Department with many youth programs available. Providing parks, facilities, and recreational programs to meet the needs of the residents of the Village





VILLAGE OF WALDEN RECREATION DEPARTMENT PROGRAMS

The Village of Walden is fortunate to have a very active Recreation and Parks Department that has many youth programs available. Below is an alphabetical listing of the programs offered, with a brief description.

Basketball - Registration begins in September, practice begins in December, and games are played in January. Games are played at the John H. Howland Teen Center at the Wooster Memorial Grove Park and Walden Elementary School (Orchard Street). Open to all Town of Montgomery Residents ages 6-18.

Beach at James W. Olley Community Park - The Beach is open June - August - from 12 - 6 p.m. daily.


Flag Football - Registration begins in April and games begin in June. Games are played at Bradley Park. Open to all Town of Montgomery residents ages 5-17.

Indoor Soccer - Registration is in September and games begin in November. Games are played at the John H. Howland Teen Center at the Wooster Memorial Grove Park. Open to all Town of Montgomery residents ages 5-12.

Outdoor Soccer - Registration is in July and games begin in September. Games are played at Bradley Park. Open to all Town of Montgomery residents ages 5-12.

Summer Day Camp - Open to all Town of Montgomery residents ages 5-15. The half day and full day programs are held at James W. Olley Community Park Monday through Friday in July and August offering daily activities including athletic games, swimming, arts and crafts, nature walks, and team building activities. There are also various field trips planned throughout the six weeks for an additional cost. Early drop off program is also available.






